

Tuition and Fees 2017/2018

Fees below are for students enrolled for a FULL year. Partial year enrollment is different.

Due with enrollment paperwork: Family Registration Fee and \$50 per student security deposit. Security deposit is returned at the end of the year when concert attire and music is returned, and your bill is paid in full.

Family Registration Fee: \$40/family. This fee will be decreased to \$10 if you are a returning family and register by August 15th with the deposit paid, or by the Orientation Meeting for new families.

Additional fees: Concert Polo: \$22 - 31, depending on the size (everyone except Elementary Music Class) or Symphony/ Concert Choir/Wind Symphony concert outfit : \$30 rental/cleaning fee

Discounts: only available for families NOT enrolled in government-subsidized programs or public-private partnerships

Multi-course discount: any additional Standard or Advanced class taken by student \$144 discount

Multi-student discounts: the first Standard or Advanced class taken by another student in the same family will receive the following discount:

Second student taking Standard or Advanced Class:	\$32 discount
Third Student taking Standard or Advanced Class:	\$48 discount
Fourth (or more) Student taking Standard or Advanced Class:	\$72 discount

In an effort to keep tuition costs down, and to facilitate the operation of the program, each family is required to choose a volunteer job for the year. Families who do not sign up will be charged an additional \$100 tuition/year. Parents must meet with the OPUS Director at Orientation or in the first month of classes to sign up.

There will be limited scholarship funds available to families needing assistance. For questions specific to your family or about financial assistance, please contact our Treasurer.

There is a New Student Orientation Meeting on Monday, August 28th at 7 pm - **Waterford branch**, or Tuesday, August 29th - **Troy branch** for all families new to OHMI. There you will have a chance to meet the Directors/Teachers, get an overview of the program, and see, hear, and be able to choose which instrument your student wants to play if they have not decided previously.
