



Varsity Letter Points Worksheet

In recognition of the achievement and performance proficiency that each student reaches through practice and development of their musical skills, OHMI will award a varsity music letter. Evidence of the performance proficiency and achievement are displayed through OHMI concerts, OHMI related festival performances, other performances and technique building experiences/activities.

Procedure: Students will earn their "letter" by accumulating the needed number of points to reach each level of the program. The points are designed to allow students who are minimally involved to achieve the Varsity level by the end of their high school career if they participate in ensemble(s) all four years of high school. The program will also recognize the motivated, high achieving student. Points are not earned until the activity is completed. If you are a freshman, your current point level is 0. If you are an upperclassman, it is the number of points you had at the end of the previous year when an application was submitted.
